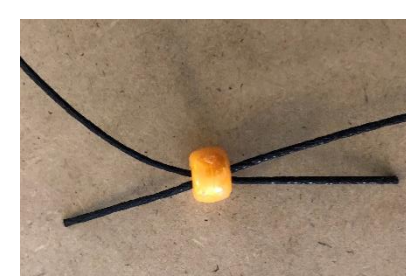
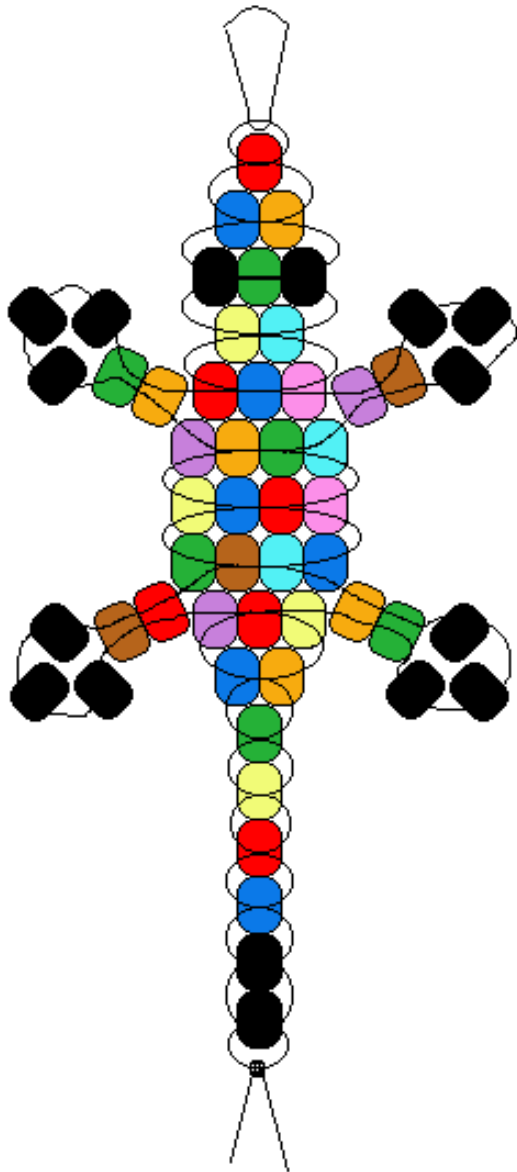


How to make a Lizard keyring



1. Start 130cm length of cord, bend it in half and place the loop through the keyring, put the ends through the loop and pull tight. Make sure the two lengths of cord are even, you can adjust the knot to ensure this.

2. Start with one bead, any colour you like. Thread the cord through the bead with one part threaded in one side and one going in the other side and pull it tight.



3. Add two beads, any colour you like. Thread the cord through both beads as you did before and pull tight.

4. Do the same with a set of 3 beads. The two beads on either side are the eyes so you can choose any colour you like but make sure they are the same so that you can tell they are eyes.

5. Making sure you pull the cords to make each section tightly fit together.

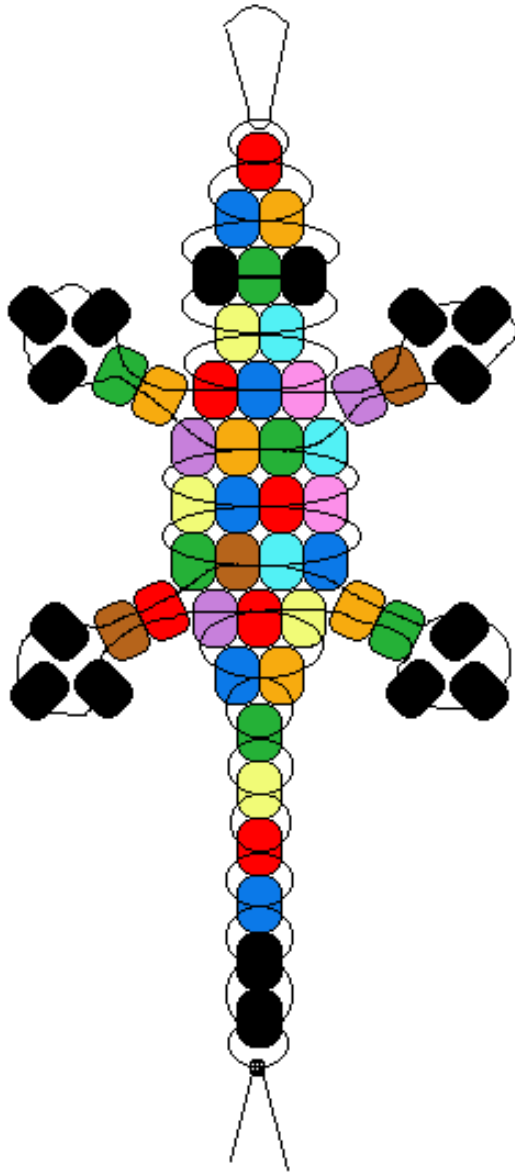


6. Add another set of 3 beads and pull them tight any colour you like.

7. To make the legs add 2 beads on one side and 2 beads on the other.

8. Then add 3 beads on one side.

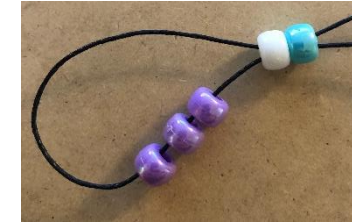

9. Loop the cord through the set of 2 beads added in step 7 leaving the 3 beads you added in step 8 loose.



10. Pull the cord tightly to create the foot. I chose 3 beads the same colour so that you can clearly see it is a foot.



11. Do the same on the other side to create the other foot. You may need to wiggle the beads around a bit to create the triangle shape.



12. Now add 4 beads. Threading the cord through both sides of the beads as you did before.



13. Repeat step 12, 2 more times so that you have 3 rows of 4 beads, making sure you pull each row tightly against the next.



14. Add a row of 3 beads next and pull tightly.



15. Now for the back legs. Repeat step 7 by adding 2 beads on either side.



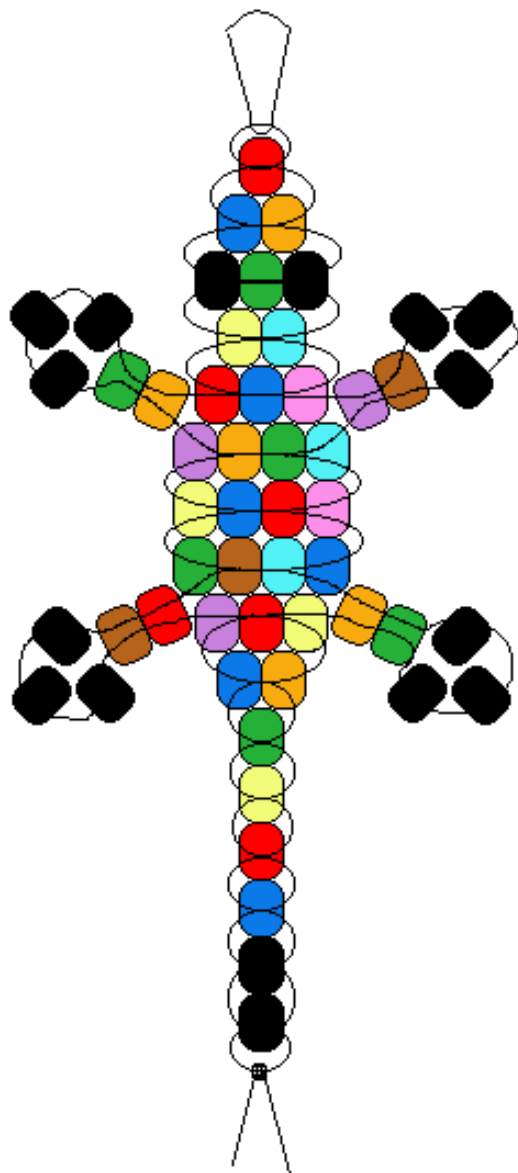
16. Then repeating steps 8-10 add 3 more beads, thread the cord through the 2 beads added in step 15 and pull tight.



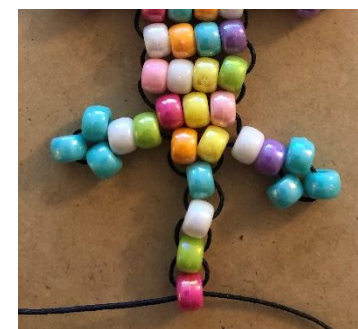
17. Repeat on the other side so that you now have 2 back legs. You could use the same colours as the front legs or choose different colours like I did here.

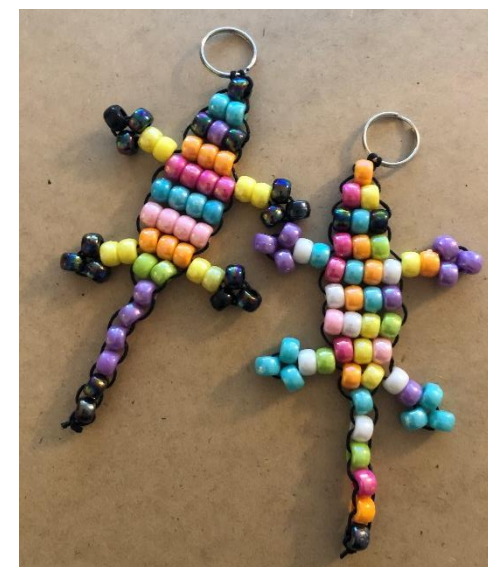
18. Finally the tail. Add one bead at a time, threading each end of the cord through either side of the bead and pulling tight.



19. Repeat this step until you have 6 beads in a row. You could make a longer tail if you want to by adding more beads in this way but I just used 6.



20. Finally tie a tight knot in the end of the tail. I do a double knot to make sure it doesn't come lose. Make sure the knot is really tight before cutting off the excess cord.



And there you have a very cute little lizard keyring. You can use any colours you like. I made one by using coloured beads to make a pattern and the other I just picked random beads.
